



User Guide ZAKATY Portal



This Guide clarifies how to use Zakaty portal, which allow individuals to voluntarily calculate and pay Zakat in a reliable manner to deliver to its beneficiaries through the Social Insurance and Empowerment Agency at the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development.



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About Zakaty

A national platform created by Zakat, Tax, and Customs Authority (ZATCA) to create a balanced and integrated zakat environment, allowing individuals to pay easily through calculating and paying the Zakat via e-payment channels to deliver it to those who are illegible who are registered in the Ministry of Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development represented by Social Insurance and Empowerment Agency.

How can you create a new account?

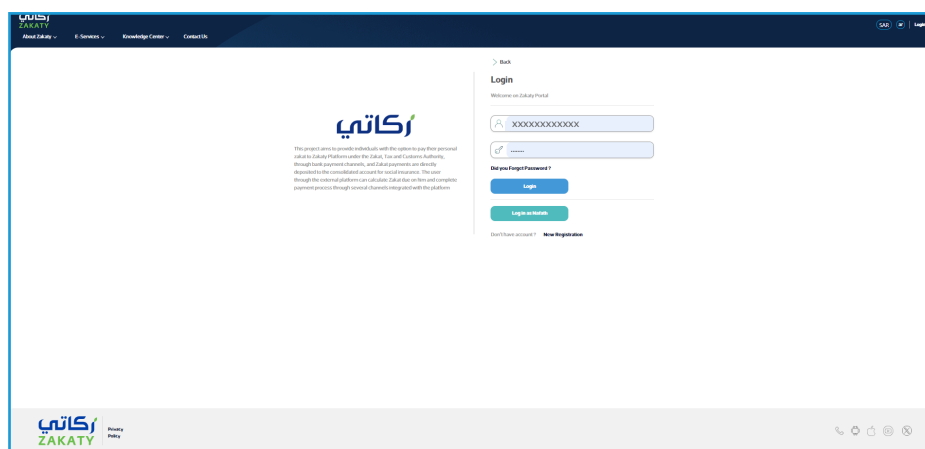

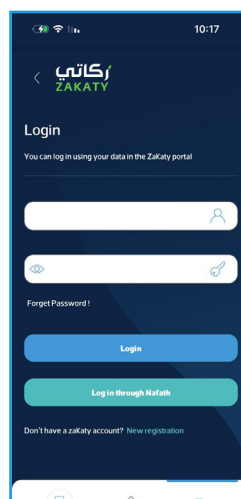
Via the National Single Sign-On Service (NAFATH)

What are the services provided by “Zakaty Portal”?

Zakaty is characterized by a group of services easing the Zakat payer to calculate and pay zakat and know the Nisab.

Via Website

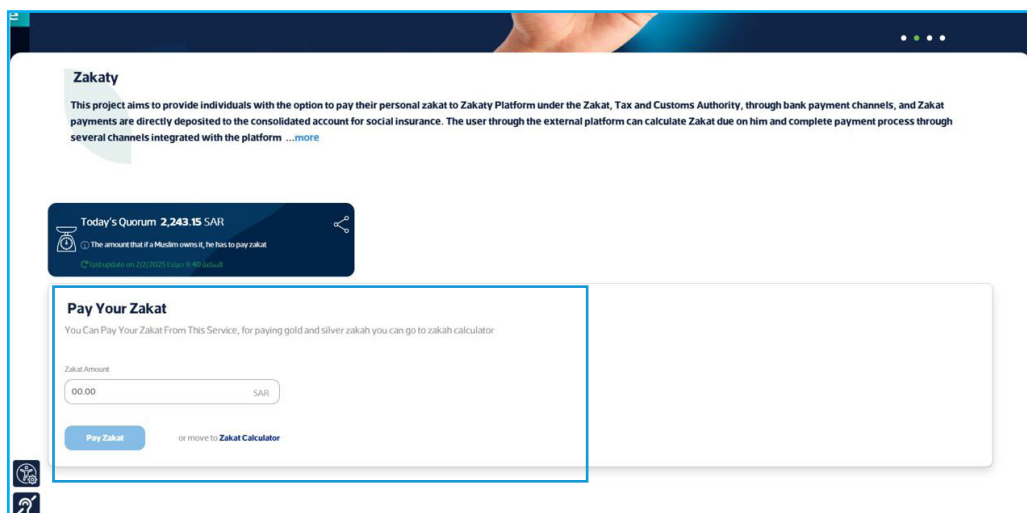
Through the (Nisab today) service, you can know the Nisab. It is the amount, if a Muslim owns it and year has passed, he has to be pay Zakat. It shall be updated according to the prices of gold and silver on instantly basis.



The Nisab is updated often to reflect changes in the price of gold and silver globally, and it may be shared on social media.

Pay your Zakat

Through this service, you can pay the Zakat amount to be collected directly through available e-channels.





How to pay via Website

Payment Channels

- Upon selecting Sadad, Sadad invoice will be issued. If the due payment is not made within the specified date, the invoice will be void.
- Payment via Sadad is made through the ATM or Bank Website through selecting the invoiced code of ZATCA and entering the Sadad number to complete the payment.

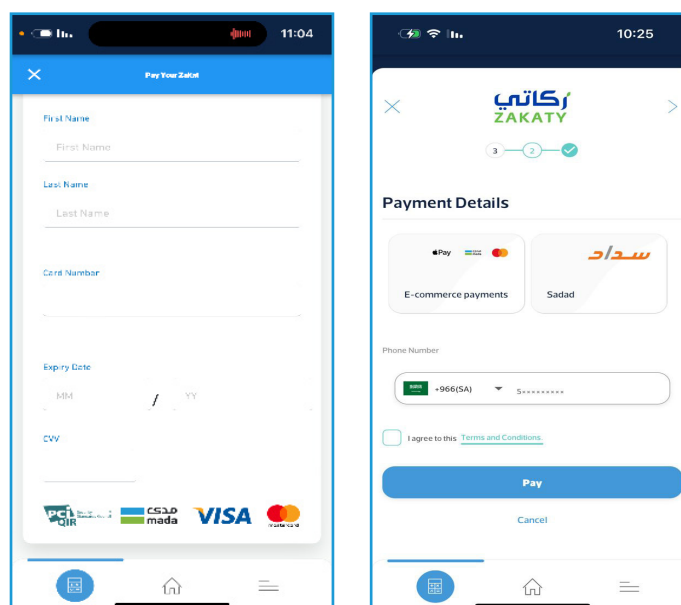

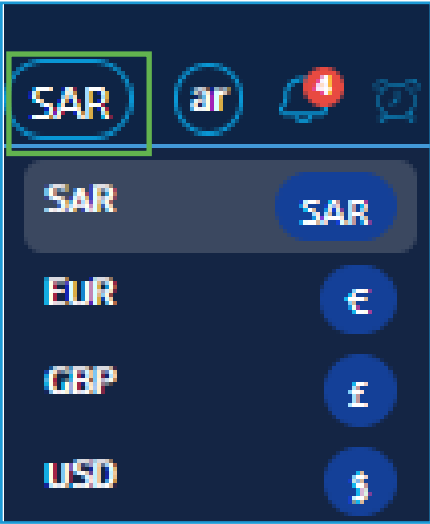

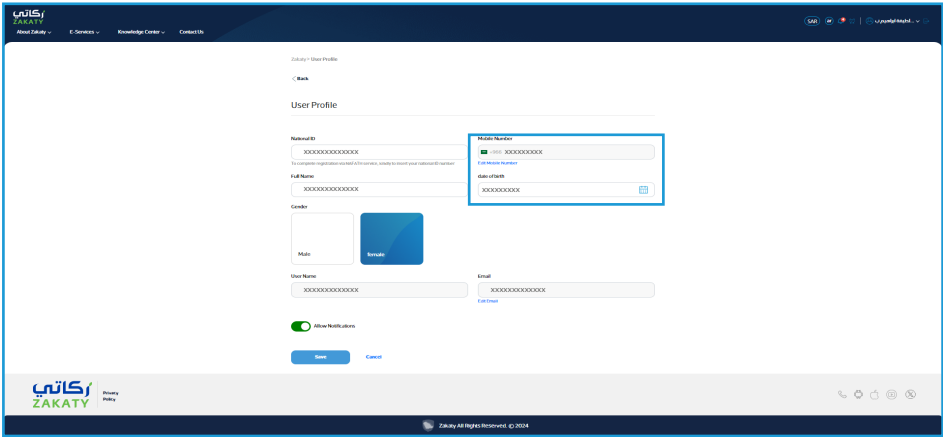

Zakat Calculator

Zakaty Portal is characterized by two calculators; short and long calculation.

Short Calculator

Calculates money zakat only. Enter the cash amount and zakat amount will be automatically calculated. Method of calculating zakat by the short calculator: All amounts owned by the Zakat payer $\div 40$. If the money reaches Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

For example:

Money $9000 \div 40 = 225$

Long Calculator

Calculates various zakat items through entering into the calculator and selecting the zakat item required.

You can select more than one item, and click on "Next". The items will be added to the table and calculated in the "Zakat Base".

How to calculate the Nisab?

Method of Gold Zakat Calculation: $\text{Net Gold} = (\text{number of grams} \times \text{karat} \div 24) \times \text{gold price at the day of zakat payment} \div 40$, knowing that gold Nisab is 85 g. If the gold reaches the quorum, zakat becomes due, and the amount due will appear. If the gold does not reach the quorum, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than 85 g.

Method of Silver Zakat Calculation: $\text{Number of grams} \times \text{silver price at the day of zakat payment} \div 40$, knowing that silver Nisab is 595 g. If the silver reaches the Nisab, zakat becomes due, and the amount due will appear. If the silver does not reach the Nisab, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than 595 g.

Method of Money Zakat Calculation: $\text{All amounts owned by the Zakat payer} \div 40$. If the money reaches Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Salary Zakat Calculation: $\text{All salaries remaining at the account within one year} \div 40$. If the salaries reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Trade Offers Zakat Calculation: $\text{All goods value at the date of zakat payment} \div 40$. If the goods reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Stock Zakat Calculation: $\text{Number of stocks} \times \text{total market value of stock less the book value} \div 40$. If the stocks reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.



Method of Debts Zakat Calculation: Number of debts instruments owned by the zakat payer $\times$ its market value at the date of zakat payment $\div 40$. If the debts reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Sukuk Zakat Calculation: Debts value $\div 40$. If the debts reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Investment Funds Zakat Calculation: Number of fund units owned by the zakat payer $\times$ its price at the date of zakat payment $\div 40$. If the units amount reaches Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.

Method of Properties Zakat Calculation: Number of the property $\times$ property market value $\div 40$. If the properties reach Nisab, the amount to be paid by the zakat payer will appear. If not, a notification clarifying that zakat base is less than the Nisab will appear.



What about the Zakat spending?

Zakat spending in Zakaty is limited in the Social Insurance and Empowerment Agency. Zakat payer can select the region and case of the beneficiary.

Via Website

You can select the region and case of the beneficiary. If not, the allocation will be made automatically.

- Select the Beneficiary Region.
- Select the Beneficiary Case.

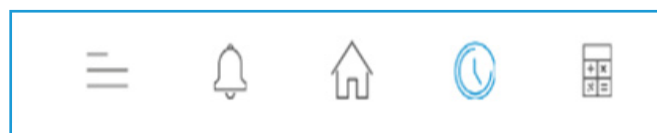

ZAKATY Q&A

Q: Can I pay Zakat from outside the Kingdom as a scholarship student?

A: Yes, payment services are possible using international phone lines.

Q: Is the gold price updated on a daily basis?

A: It is updated accurately and on a daily basis by connecting the ZAKATY Platform to the gold price website.

Q: Can Zakat be calculated on foreign stock?

A: Yes, the Zakat calculator includes a foreign stock option as well as various stock options.

Q: Can I pay with a Visa card?

A: Yes, you can make payments with a Visa card and alternative methods.

Q: How can Saudi stocks be reliably calculated?

A: Based on connecting ZAKATY to the Saudi Exchange platform (Tadawul).

Q: Is it possible to calculate Zakat on many items?

A: Yes, you can input more than one Zakat item into the calculator to get the total Zakat base and the amount of Zakat due.

Q: Does ZATCA collect a certain amount of Zakat payments?

A: No, all Zakat payments are sent toward beneficiaries of social security and empowerment by the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development.
